Dear Scouts,


The District Scout About Challenge, is based at the District Activity Centre, The Canyon. Six hours of non-competitive, fun activities, including; archery, making and using a home-made survival stove, building a small Patrol box from wood and branding your Patrols name on it, as well as geocaching. Patrols/teams of between 4 and 7 Scouts can enter, with each Patrol taking away a survival stove and a small Patrol box for use at Scouts and camps (ideal for Patrol camps like Colonel Woods!)

We meet at The Canyon for 9:30am, with activities starting at 10am. Each activity session lasts an hour. The wood work project is spread over three one-hour sessions, the other activities last an hour each. All the activities will be based around the Canyon, except for the Geocaching where we will venture in to the grounds of Fairlands Valley Showground. A buffet style lunch will be provided for all participants before activities continue into the afternoon.
