We plan to build and fly model planes when we get back to Datchworth and each Patrol will have a session of archery on Sunday morning. Your Scout Leaders will help you decide what to take to camp and help you plan your menu and shopping list over the next few of Troop evenings.

This year there will be an option to enter as a competitive Patrol if you wish. For those Patrols we will judge some cooking and camping elements (details in the Patrol planning pack) and the Colonel Woods and Outdoor Cooking competition trophies will be up for grabs. For those that don't want to compete; that is absolutely fine, your leaders can work with you to help you with your camping and cooking skills as needed. So ideal if your Patrol is new to camping! Come and join us and gain some new skills while having loads of fun!
